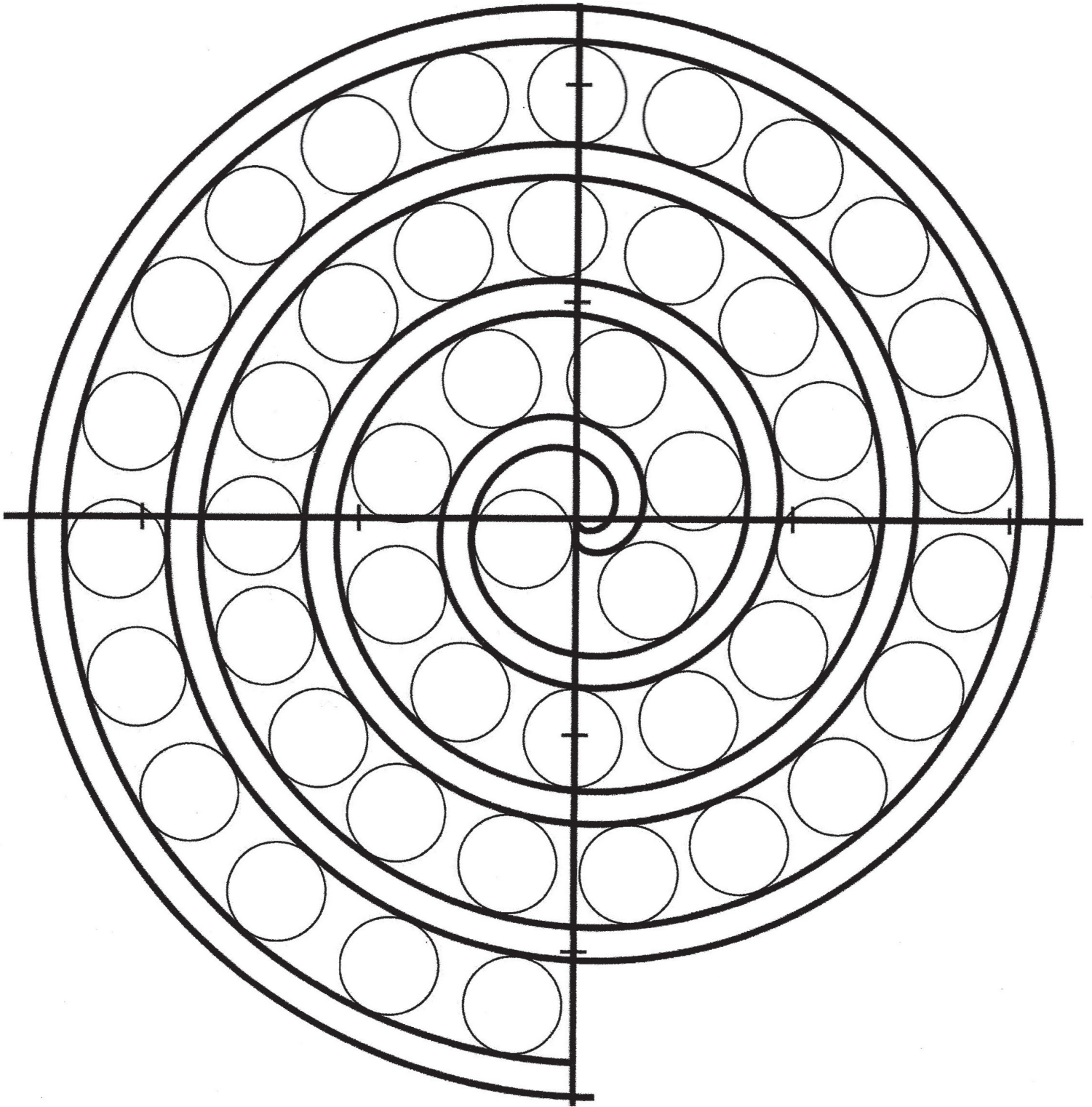


PRAY IN COLOR: Each day, choose a word to ponder or a person to pray for. Write the word or name in the allotted space with a pen and draw or doodle around it. Add color with colored pencils or markers. Let the word or name speak to you. If words come to you as you draw, pray them. If not, just continue to draw, stay quiet, and let the word or name burrow into your mind and heart. Returning to the calendar each day establishes a special time to be present to God and to listen.

MARK THE JOURNEY: Lent is a long season and it's easy to get lost before Holy Week arrives. To keep the season, place a sticker in the first circle on Ash Wednesday, continue placing a sticker-a-day in the next circle until together we arrive at the center, Easter.
