

CALL TO WORSHIP ~ John 4:7-12,18-19 (adapted from The Message)

My beloved friends, let us continue to love each other since love comes from God. Everyone who loves is born of God and experiences a relationship with God.

This is how God showed his love for us: God sent his only Son into the world so we might live through him. This is the kind of love we are talking about—

not that we once upon a time loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to clear away our sins and the damage they've done to our relationship with God.

If God loved us like this, we ought to love each other. No one has seen God, but if we love one another, God dwells deeply within us, and his love becomes complete in us—perfect love!

God is love. We live in God and God lives in us, so we are free of worry on Judgment Day—our standing in the world is identical with Christ's.

There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear; whoever fears has not reached perfection in love. We love because he first loved us.
